SDCC will have had some competitors on the day and no doubt we will find out all about it at our next meeting.

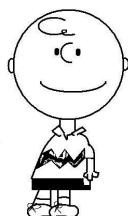
WINTON 6 HOUR

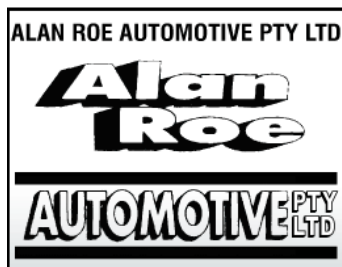
