Unfortunately, the Captain and Vice-Captain will be away for this event. Therefore, we will need as many people to help on the day so the event runs as smoothly as it has in the past.

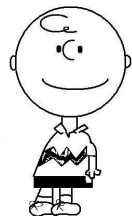
For information to Club Plate members, this is an event where you are required to help out so contact Jim or Andrew and let them know you'll be there.

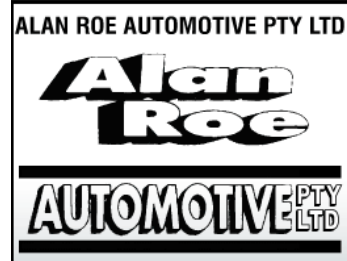
