In the special class, Darryn Bohm brought out his twin powered (that means a motor in the front and back) Corolla went quite smart for the day.

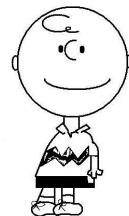

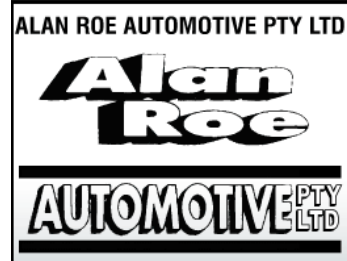
