1. PLACE AND DATE

The Event is a 2 day Event and will be held on Saturday 7th August and Sunday 8th August 2021 at the SHEPPARTON & DISTRICT CLUB track, Little Road Mooropna. On Saturday 7th August 2021 Scrutineering will commence at 11.00am. Driver's Briefing at 1pm followed by Parade Lap will be at 1.15pm. Come and Try to follow straight after. It may continue in twilight weather permitting. Sunday 8th August 2021. Scrutineering will commence at 8.30am. Driver's Briefing at 9am followed by Parade Lap will be at 9.15am. Come and Try to follow straight after.

This is a normal club event for both clubs. Entries must be submitted by the due date. The normal entry fee needs to be paid for these days. The Parade will be in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

2. ENTRIES

SINGLE ENTRY

Come and Try Round Saturday OR Sunday ONLY: \$45 for all drivers

Saturday AND Sunday: \$80 for all drivers

FAMILY ENTRY: 2 members of one family living at the same address

Come and Try Round Saturday OR Sunday ONLY: \$70 for all drivers

Saturday AND Sunday: \$130 for all drivers

ADDITIONAL FAMILY ENTRY: If more than 2 members of one family living at the same address, each additional family member will be charged the following:

Come and Try Round Saturday OR Sunday ONLY: \$10

Saturday AND Sunday: \$15

(e) An entry will only be deemed valid when payment is received with a signed entry form.

(f) There will be a maximum of four drivers per vehicle

(g) The promoter reserves the right to refuse an entry in accordance with the NCR's.

(h) When paying an entry fee for one or both days the amount must be entered on the Entry form.

(i) Non-Members of the Shepparton & District Car Club will need to sign up for a day membership with Shepparton & District Car Club.

3. CLASSES

(Drivers will be graded into the following classes)

P Standard Production (2WD, Road Tyres Only, No Modifications allowed)

C 0-1600cc Modified (2WD, No Firewall Modifications, Similar Engine Only (Make & No of cyl))

D 1601-2000cc Modified (2WD, No Firewall Modifications, Similar Engine Only (Make & No of cyl)
E Over 2000cc Modified (2WD, No Firewall Modifications, Similar Engine Only (Make & No of cyl)
J Juniors – Aged 14 -18yo as of 1st January 2019 (see following note).
L Ladies (See following note)
S Specials (Custom built cars and excessively modified sedans)
W Production Based 4WD or AWD (no tyre restrictions apply)
F Fun class Just for the fun of it.

Junior Competitors must be under the age of 18 years, on 1 January of the year of competition.

Juniors may compete in any class of vehicle but will be ineligible for class points in class W or S vehicles. If a Junior enters a class S or W car they shall compete in the appropriate open class regardless of their age.

A junior competitor whom competes in an "open" class must continue to compete in an "open" class for the remainder of the year.

Ladies who drive a Class S or W vehicle must compete in the Class S or W for the rest of the year.

4. STARTING ORDER

Lining up on the grid, it is the Driver's responsibility to make sure they have completed the required runs.

5. DRIVERS

(a) The Event will be open to members of the SDCC and who are holders of a current Motorsport Australia Speed/Speed junior or superior licence.

(b) All Competitors are required to wear snug fitting clothes covering the body from neck to wrist to ankles and suitable footwear. Clothing should be of a **fire resistant nature**. All apparel, including helmets must comply with the requirements of Schedule D of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

(c) INSTRUCTORS AND INEXPERIENCED DRIVERS

If the Club Chief believes an inexperienced Driver needs an Instructor in the car with him/her, he will arrange for an Instructor to be appointed and go with that Driver. This will continue until the Instructor is satisfied that the Driver is competent to go on his/her own.

(d) PARENTAL CONSENT If any Competitor or Driver is under 18 years of age, the consent of his/her Parent or Guardian must appear on the Entry Form. The Parent/Guardian must stay at the track.

6. PASSENGERS

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.

7. COURSE

The event will be run over 1.6km (approx) of gravel/dirt defined by tyres, witches hats and bunting.

8. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

(a) Vehicles must conform with the General Requirements for Cars and Drivers as per Schedules A and B of the current Motorsport Australia Manual. All vehicles must be fitted with a suitable front and back towing hook.

(b) All vehicles must be fitted with two separate fastening systems on any opening front panel in accordance with Schedule B.

(c) Fire extinguishers to a standard listed in Schedule H of the Motorsport Australia Manual must be securely fitted to the vehicle. As per the current Motorsport Australia Manual **Each AS1841 standard fire extinguisher shall be serviced every three years.**

(d) Any vehicles competing in Class S must be fitted with rollover protection. Rollover protection is highly recommended in all other cases as per Schedule J of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

(e) Fuel shall be with Schedule G Motorsport Australia Manual

9. RUNNING DETAIL

The number of runs will be determined by the Clerk of the Course, dependent on the condition of the track.

10. STARTING PROCEDURE

Competitors will line up in lane order and will be moved onto the starting pad as instructed. The starter will indicate to the Driver when to proceed onto the course via lights or signals.

Multiple Driver cars and working officials who may also be Competitor will have a separate staging lane to be able to queue quickly to even out the runs against single drive cars.

At the end of each run the driver is to immediately decelerate the vehicle and proceed to the pit area. At all times when moving within the pit area and leaving the autocross area, the maximum speed limit is to be 10kph.

12. REFUELING OF VEHICLES

This may only be carried out in the designated refuelling area located near the parking area. NO REFUELING IS TO BE CARRIED OUT IN THE PITS OR PADDOCK.

The Organisers reserve the right to stop the Event at any time if they consider it necessary, in the interests of safety or for any other reason.

13. POSTPONEMENTS OR ABANDONMENT

The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon, or cancel the Event under the NCR's, or if insufficient entries are received. If the Event is cancelled or postponed for more than 24 hours, the entry fees shall be refunded in full.

14. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au

15. NOISE

Vehicles must not exceed a noise limit of 95dB (A).

16. PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR's and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

17. SATURDAY TEA

Tea Saturday night will be a Pizza night. The cost is \$12 per person. Under 10 is free.

Payment made be made during the day.

A variety of Pizzas are ordered from a local Pizza shop.

- This event is a come and try event and no prizes or points will be awarded.

- **COVID 19 REQUIREMENTS**

This event will be ran in accordance with the Venue COVID Plan to ensure compliance with government regulations and to ensure the safety of all participants and competitors.

In all matters of dispute or questions regarding the application of the COVID plan the nominated COVID Checker will be considered the Judge of Fact and their decision final.

- **All entries will only be accepted via the online Motorsport Australia event entry portal. All entries must be finalised by Thursday 22nd October 2020. There will be NO on the day entries accepted.**
- **Drivers Briefing and Scrutineering will be conducted with social distancing principals in place.**
- **The area under the roof in front of the container will be limited access. Signage will be in place.**
- **The timing booth and container will be NO ACCESS to anyone other than authorised officials.**
- **Multiple drivers in the same vehicle must be from the same household.**
- **No Passenger rides will be allowed on the day.**
- **All persons entering the venue must agree to comply with the COVID Plan and all**

signage on site, a copy of this plan will be available on the day.

In addition to this by submitting an entry you are confirming that:

- You or any member of your household has NOT entered any COVID Hot Spots or the Greater Melbourne Area in the last 14 days and will not do so between the time of your entry and the event.
- You have not come into contact with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID 19 in the last 14 days prior to the event.
- You agree that if you are feeling any symptoms of COVID 19 on the day of the event you will not attend the site. In this case your entry fee will be refunded in full.
